Job Summary:

Eel River Bar First Nation is searching for an individual to provide professional social services to clients with priority on youth and children of the community. The work involves therapeutic intervention with children, adults and families within the Family Enhancement /Prevention Program. Under the direct supervision of the Program Director the successful will become proficient with the duties of a Community out-reach Social Worker, School youth services and Child Prevention Services. Training and support will be provided upon availability.

Job Description: *Adhering to the ERBFN CFS Conditions of Employment Policies and maintaining **Confidentiality** at all times, the Social Worker (SWII) Prevention Program responsibilities will include but not limited to:*

- Develop prevention programs/activities to better serve the Community
- Work in collaboration with the cultural coordinator and liaise with community agencies and supports.
- Be proactive within the community by facilitating workshops, groups, etc., as required
- Counselling children struggling with behavior management issues at the school, counselling and assessing adults with addictions,
- Assisting Child Protection SWs with supportive services,
- Responding to walk-ins in crisis and linking with other programs and committees to improve community services for youths.
- Be responsible for case management & documentation with NB Families, establishing and maintaining effective working relationships with clients, staff, community, and with internal and external professionals as well as sit on committees

ESSENTIAL QUALIFICATIONS:

- A Bachelor's Degree in Social work and must be active registered member in good standing of New Brunswick Association of Social Workers
- A knowledge on addictions and the effects on individuals and families
- Knowledge of First Nation socio economic realities and the provision of culturally safe care and a genuine interest in working with Mi'kmaq culture.
- Ability to use office technology, software and applications/NB Families
- Excellent written and oral communication skills in English
- Reliability, sound judgment, adaptability and flexibility
- Critical thinking and decision making skills
- Planning an organization skills
