# Brunswick Smelter Bursary

#### Overview

- The Brunswick Smelter team is establishing a \$1,000 bursary for students from each of the communities of Ugpi'ganjig/Eel River Bar and Oinpegitjoig/Pabineau First Nations as well as one additional \$1,000 bursary for the remainder of the communities represented by Mi'gmawe'l Tplu'taqnn Inc.
- This \$1,000 bursary has been established for five years beginning in the 2023/24 academic year.
- Applications are currently being sought for the 2024/2025 academic year.
- The bursary will be open to students pursuing studies in science, environment, engineering or trades and is
  open to students regardless of their year of study.

### **Eligibility Requirements**

- Band Member of:
  - Oinpegitjoig/Pabineau First Nation
  - Ugpi'ganjig/Eel River Bar First Nations
  - Another community represented by Mi'gmawe'l Tplu'taqnn Inc.
- Entering or enrolled in a full-time post-secondary education program at a recognized Canadian postsecondary institution in the areas of science, environment, engineering or trades. Programs of study may be academic, vocational, technical, or technological.
- Able to demonstrate one or more of community involvement, academic excellence, leadership qualities and career objectives which will make a positive contribution in society.
- Application must be received by the bursary deadline.

## **Application Process**

- Applicants will be asked to submit an application and essay stating their academic and career objectives as well as outline any special achievements (community, academic, etc.).
- Applications will be due by July 31, 2024.

Demonstrated Leadership	40%

#### **Selection Process**

- Each year, the Brunswick Smelter
   Decommissioning Team will assemble a
   Bursary Selection Committee comprised
   of three First Nations community
   members and two Brunswick Smelter
   members.
- The Committee will assess all submissions under the terms of the approved evaluation criteria.
- The Successful candidate will be advised of their award by approximately September 30, 2024.
- Bursary funds will be made available to the successful applicant by November 30, 2024.
