



Voting Instructions For the new Ugpi'Ganjig First Nation fisheries management and development plan.

In Person Voting

Members of Ugpi'Ganjig First Nation and those who live within 25 kilometers of Ugpi'Ganjig will be asked to vote in person in the Kitpu Room at the main entrance of the Band Office. Ballots will be handed out to each member. A membership list will be used to manage who has voted; this will ensure community members vote only once.

In-person voting will take place on May 22, 2025, from 10:00am to 4:00pm, including lunch hour. For those who require transportation within Ugpi'Ganjig can contact Gilbert from the Health Center at 506-684-0805.

Mail-in Voting

Members of Ugpi'Ganjig First Nation living more than 25 kilometers away will be mailed ballots. Envelopes will include an executive summary of the report, the ballots and a self-addressed stamped envelope.

You must write your name on the label on the top left of the return envelope to ensure your ballots get counted. Please note, ballots will remain anonymous. Anyone interested in voting is encouraged to mail their ballot back quickly as all votes will be counted on June 2, 2025, starting at 4:00pm.

Results of the vote will be shared with the community no later than June 3, 2025.
