

Eel River Bar First Nation

Emergency Financial Assistance Support Policy

Purpose

The purpose of this policy is to provide financial assistance to members of Eel River Bar First Nation who are experiencing unexpected crises or emergency situations that create an undue financial burden on their daily lives.

Eligibility

- Applicants must be registered members of Eel River Bar First Nation.
 - Applicants must be **18 years of age or older**.
 - Applicants may reside **on or off reserve**.

Funding Guidelines

- Eligible applicants may receive **up to a maximum of \$500 per fiscal year**.
 - Assistance is intended for **unexpected crises or emergency situations**.
 - Applicants are responsible for clearly identifying and explaining the financial hardship they are experiencing.

Application Limits

- A maximum of **100 applications** will be approved per fiscal year.
 - Applications will be reviewed on a **first-come, first-served basis**.
 - Funding is available **until funds are exhausted**.
 - **Unused funds will not be carried forward** into the next fiscal year.

Application Requirements

Applicants must submit a complete application package including:

1. A **completed and signed application form**
 2. **Proof of Eel River Bar First Nation membership**
 3. A **written letter** detailing the crisis or emergency situation being experienced




