## Strictest Controls (Moose)

**Increased Risk Assessment:** One (1) of the following triggers will need to be met to trigger Eel River Bar Operations from the Orange “Fox” Phase into the Red “Moose” Phase.

- **Eel River Bar Trigger:** Confirmed case within community or within Band operated Buildings and Projects.
- **Provincial Trigger:** Province transitions zone 5 into Red zone.
- **Confirmed In-Community Exposure(s) Trigger:** 3 or more Community Members directed by Public Health to self-isolate.

**Decreasing Risk Assessment:** Refer to Transition Period “Smolt”.

### Guidelines

**Essential Services (Strict Controls)** Band Buildings and Operations will remain closed; however, there will be no interruption in the delivery of essential services. Staff who are required to work will perform their duties remotely.

**Health Services (Strict Controls):** The Ugpi’ganjig Health Centre will remain closed to the public; however, clients will be able to schedule appointments with the Community Health Nurse. Home and Community Care services will continue operations. Staff who are required to work will perform their duties remotely. Mental Health and Addiction services are available upon request and will be conducted remotely.

## Transition Period (Smolt)

### Transition Assessment:

- Transition from Moose Phase to Fox Phase will occur once there has been 14 consecutive days of no new cases.

### Guidelines

**Essential Services (Strict Controls):** Band Buildings and Operations will remain closed; however, there will be no interruption in the delivery of essential services. Staff who are required to work will perform their duties remotely.

**Health Services (Strict Controls):** The Ugpi'ganjig Health Centre will remain closed to the public; however, clients will be able to schedule appointments with the Community Health Nurse. Home and Community Care services will continue operations. Staff who are required to work will perform their duties remotely. Mental Health and Addiction services are available upon request and will be conducted remotely.

**Gradually Reopening (Fox)**

**Increasing Risk Assessment:** One (1) of the following triggers will need to be met to trigger Eel River Bar Operations from the Yellow “Sunflower” Phase into the Orange “Fox” Phase.

- **Provincial Trigger:** Province transitions zone 5 into Orange zone.
- **Confirmed In-Community Exposure(s) Trigger:** 2 or less Community Members directed by Public Health to self-isolate.

**Decreasing Risk Assessment:** One (1) of the following triggers will need to be met to trigger Eel River Bar Operations from the Red Phase into the Orange “Fox” Phase

- **Eel River Bar Trigger:** 0 confirmed cases within Eel River Bar, within essential services. e.g. Schools, Clinics, Hospitals, Grocery Stores, Post Offices, Gas Stations, Pharmacies, Liquor Stores, Cannabis Dispensaries.
- **Provincial Trigger:** Province transitions zone 5 into Orange zone.
- **Confirmed In-Community Exposure(s) Trigger:** Under 3 Community Members directed by Public Health to self-isolate.

**Guidelines**

**Projects and activities that can ensure COVID-19 mandatory order guideline compliance (Open but with maximum of 10 people or less):** All band projects and activities will continue in the Fox phase however employees must adhere to Eel River Bar’s health and safety guidelines as outlined in the COVID-19 Operational Guide.

**Essential Services (Open with accommodations when possible and zero tolerance for non-compliance):** Entrances for all Band Buildings will remain closed to the public. Visitors will not be permitted access during the Fox Phase and operations will be reduced to 3 days per week (Monday, Wednesday and Thursday). For employees with health considerations (immune-compromised) or who are emotionally compromised; the employee and supervisor can discuss alternate accommodations, if possible.

**Essential Services (Strict Controls with zero tolerance for non-compliance, Reduced Operations):** Entrances for all Band Buildings will remain closed to the public. Visitors will not be permitted access during the Salmon Phase operations will be reduced to 3 days per week (Monday, Wednesday and Thursday).

**Health Services (Strict Controls with zero tolerance for non-compliance, Reduced Operations):** The Ugpi'ganjig Health Centre will remain closed to the public; however, clients will be able to schedule appointments with the Community Health Nurse. Home and Community Care services will continue operations. Mental Health and Addiction services are available upon request and will be conducted remotely.

**Daycare (Open with accommodations when possible and zero tolerance for non-compliance):** Entrances for all Band Buildings will remain closed to the public. ### Guidelines

**Eel River Bar COVID-19 Operational Guide:** Please refer to the COVID-19 Operational Guide provided to you by your supervisor for further directives.

**Essential Services (reduced operations):** Entrances for all Band Buildings will remain closed to the public. Visitors will not be permitted access during the Sunflower Phase operations will be reduced to 4 days per week (Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday).

**Health Services (Strict Controls):** Entrances for the Ugpi’ganjig will remain closed to the public. Visitors will not be permitted access during the Sunflower Phase operations will be reduced to staggered staff, 5 days per week.

**Daycare (Reopen with tailored operational guide):** Entrances for all Band Buildings will remain closed to the public. For further details, review the tailored operational guide for Daycare services.

**Head Start, Pre-School and Leadership (Open with tailored operational guide):** Entrances for all Band Buildings will remain closed to the public. For further details, review the tailored operational guide for Head Start, Pre-School and Leadership services.
